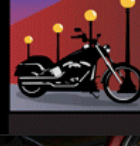

They continue to tour relentlessly because they just love to play and after every show they go out to meet their fans. QUIET RIOT is a rock & roll phenomenon. Quiet Riot hit mega-success with their first-ever US release in 1983, the classic 'Metal Health'. Spawning two hit singles that have gone on to become synonymous with heavy metal - 'Cum On Feel the Noize' and 'Metal Health' - the 'Metal Health' album went on to become the first-ever metal US debut to hit the #1 spot on the Billboard album charts, and resulted in a sold-out arena shows and non-stop MTV video airplay. However, it was the DuBrow-Banali-Wright-Gross line-up that proved to be DuBrow's favorite touring line-up (and also, most stable). Quiet Riot is currently firming up plans for a full U.S. tour - their first in three years. And with the aforementioned documentary on the horizon, and the band's music being used in hit films ('The Wrestler', 'Tropic Thunder'), video games ('Guitar Hero Encore: Rocks the 80's'), and even musicals ('Rock of Ages') - as well as QR being name-checked in songs by Weezer and Ben Folds - Quiet Riot remains a major force in heavy metal. And soon, you will get a chance to bang your head once more to Quiet Riot!

Legendary rock band Sweet (aka The Sweet) shot to the top of the charts in the 1970s with such hits as 'Ballroom Blitz', 'Fox on the Run', 'Love is Like Oxygen', 'Little Willy', 'Hellraiser', 'Teenage Rampage', 'Blockbuster' and 'Action'. The new band recorded a cover version of the Beatles' "Ticket to Ride," which was included on Cleopatra Records' "Abbey Road," a Fab Four tribute CD that was released in March 2009. April 2009 saw the release of a new two-disc, career-spanning greatest hits album called "Action: The Sweet Anthology," which was released on Shout Factory Records and received a coveted four-star rating in Rolling Stone Magazine. A preview of the band's new CD "Live in America," which was recorded live by Westwood One at the Marongo Casino in Cabazon, California on August 30, 2008, was featured on KLOS's "Front Row" program on April 12, 2009. The CD, which was first sold at shows and via the band's online store, was released worldwide in an exclusive deal with Amazon.com on July 21, 2009. The release has garnered favorable reviews in the Rock n Roll Report, Classic Rock Revisited and Hard Rock Haven, among others.

Mark Slaughter is best known as the energetic frontman with the glass shattering vocals for the hard rock group "Slaughter". Mark picked up his first guitar at age 11 and never looked back. In 1986, Mark auditioned to sing for the Vinnie Vincent Invasion and joined the band as lead singer later that year. VVI's number one hit "Love Kills" appeared on the "Nightmare on Elm Street 4" movie soundtrack in 1988. Slaughter soared to the top, touring the globe with bands they grew up with, such as Alice Cooper, Kiss and Ozzy Osbourne. Slaughter's first two albums went platinum, selling in excess of five million records in the 1990s and toured worldwide to sold-out arenas. Slaughter influenced a generation of rock music fans with hits on the Billboard charts, including "Up All Night", "Fly to the Angels", "Wild Life", "Real Love", "Spend My Life", "Mad About You" and "Days Gone By". Slaughter hits collectively spent over a year in number one video slot on MTV. In 1991 won the American Music Award (AMA) for the Best New Heavy Metal Band. Slaughter continues to tour to appreciative fans worldwide.

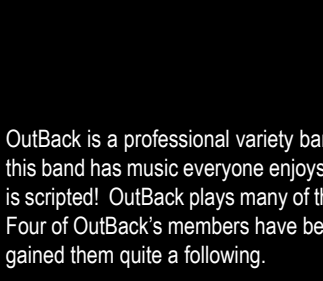
The SuperNauts
